M.Ed. Course

Must possess the B.Ed., degree awarded by the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University or any other University Recognised by U.G.C. with minimum 50% in both theory & practical.

In addition to theoretical classes, students are encouraged to participate in seminars, projects, assignments, discussions, workshops & field trips for holistic development.

Probation Period B.Ed., Course

Every students teacher admitted shall be considered to be on probation for 60 working days and if he / she does not prove to be an efficient teacher he / she will be required to leave the institution.

Code of Conduct

The Working day is divided into two sessions and each session into three periods of one hour each. The morning session is from 09.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and afternoon session is from 12.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.

Daily the first session begins with a common prayer meeting. The first warning bell will ring at 8.50 a.m. And the second at 8.55 a.m. attendance to the prayer meeting is compulsory.

At the First warning bell before each session, students should go to their respective classes and take their seats so as to be present when the lecturer enters.

At the commencement of each period when the lecturer enters the class, students are expected to stand up and greet.

No Student would be allowed into the classroom during class hours without the permission of the lecture. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the staff member before the class is dispersed. Students should be regular and punctual in attendance. Strict silence should be maintained during class hours and also in the college premises. A representative for each class will be selected at the beginning of each year.

He / She will help the staff in maintaining the discipline of the college. Fellow students will support them and help them in all the college activities during the year.

When classes are supersede, students are expected to leave the room in a quiet and orderly manner giving way to the staff members. Strict silence and order must be maintained while moving from one class to another. No disturbance should be caused to the other classes.

Students should take care not to damage the properties of the college. Cost of repair of damage caused will be recovered from the student who is responsible.

Unauthorized entry of outsiders into the campus is strictly prohibited. Students shall not bring or entertain outsiders within the campus.

Students shall not engage in political (or) communal activities. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against those who in any way disturb the atmosphere of the college. Being a co-educational college the students should follow a good dress code. They are expected to be neat, clean and simple in their dress. They should uphold the standards of honesty, respect and courtesy towards all.

Petition and Complaints

Request, Petition, appeal and complaints of any kind must be addressed to the Principal.

Students are not allowed to make a complaint as a body or to address any authority in a collective petition. Such combined action is subversive of good order.

Attendance and Leave rules

1. Each student is required to attend classes without fail.
2. The absence of a student without leave for any single period would result in the loss of a attendance for the whole session.
3. A student, who needs leave, shall apply in prescribed form to the principal with prior permission and signature of the class teacher. After sanctioning, the leave letter should be submitted to discipline committee chairman.
4. Leave applied on medical grounds should be accompanied by a medical certificate.
5. No leave will be granted prior to or in continuation of holidays.
6. On absence of 15 consecutive working days without leave application, the students will automatically be removed from the rolls of the college.
7. Shortfall in attendance shall not be recommended for condo nation.

8. The certificate of attendance and progress report required for admission to the university examination will be granted only if.

- ❖ A student has more than 90% of attendance.
- ❖ The Student has completed the courses to the satisfaction of authorities concerned.
- ❖ The progress in studies and conduct in the college and outside has been satisfactory.

Hostel

Separate hostel facilities are provided for men and women.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

1. Overnight stay outside the hostel is not permitted.
2. Students will be permitted to go out only with their parents or authorized guardians.
3. Permission will not be granted for taking tuitions outside.
4. Parents should apply to the authorities and get written permission for grant of leave for their wards.
5. Other than parents or authorized guardians, others will not be allowed to visit the students in the hostel.
6. For leave on medical grounds, the leave application should be accompanied by a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.

7. Students should retire to their rooms strictly before 10.30 p.m. and are not allowed to stay and chat in other rooms.
8. Food stuff, utensils like tumblers, plates, spoons should not be carried to the rooms from the canteen.
9. The hostel fees paid is for the whole year and if a student wants to leave the hostel in the middle of the year for whatever reasons, the fees paid shall not be refunded at any cost.
10. College buses are only for the day scholars and hostel students are not allowed to board collegebuses.
11. Students are not permitted to keep electrical or electronics items like radios, heaters, iron box in their rooms.
12. Any grievance should be reported to the warden in writing.
13. Students are required to maintain cleanliness in their rooms.
14. Students would be governed by rules and regulations framed by the Management from time to time.

Examinations and Tests

All the students are expected to write the examinations to be held at the end of the term. They should also take the tests and assignments given by the faculty members during the class hours from time to time.

University Examination

Identity card issued by the college should be brought to the college each day of the examination along with the hall ticket.

Scholarship

1. Scholarships are sanctioned by the Ministry of Education; Government of India. An application for the same should be made on or before the 15th October of the academic year. Late applications would not be entertained.
2. Adi - Dravida and Tribal Welfare Department Govt. of Tamil Nadu offers loans to SC & ST students for their hostel fees.
3. Disbursement of scholarship is subject to regular attendance and satisfactory progress of the students teachers. They are particularly warned against misconduct or absence for any reason whether prior to or in continuation of college holidays.

Bus & Railway Concessions

Students coming from suburban areas can obtain railway concession and bus season tickets at concessional rates by applying in the prescribed forms.

Physical Education, SUPW, Red Cross and C.S.S

Physical Education and SUPW are integral parts of the B.Ed. Programme. Attendance is compulsory for all these activities. Performance of the student in all these activities will be recorded and graded.

Yoga and spoken English are taught to all students

Tutorial System

For effective guidance and supervision, each student's teacher will be attached to a member of the faculty, who will be his / her tutor and counsellor with whom he / she can discuss problems. The tutor will keep in close touch with them and monitor their progress to enhance their academic performance.

College Union

1. All the Student teachers and the members of the teaching faculty are members of the College Union. The Principal is the Chair Person and the Vice Chair Person will be nominated by the Principal. A President, a Secretary and a Joint Secretary will be elected by the students among themselves.
2. An association shall be formed for each department subject - wise.

Alumni Association

All the outgoing students are members of the association. The subscription for annual membership is Rs. 500/- and the subscription for the life membership is Rs. 5000/- Life membership is very much encouraged because it helps to build up longstanding rapport with the Alma Mater.

Library rules

Perfect order and strict silence should be maintained in the library.

Any discussion should be kept outside the library.

Working Hours

The library will be kept open from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on all working days.

Admissions to the library

All the staff members and students of the college are privileged to have direct access to the books. No one is allowed to bring any other book / article inside the library.

Privileges of the members

Each member will be given two library tickets and two books will be issued at a time.

Library cards will be supplied to the students by the college at the beginning of the academic year. In case the card is lost, the librarian should be informed of the fact at once. The owner of the card will be responsible for the books issued on that card. The card lost may be replaced with the duplicate on payment of Rs. 25/-.

Books will be issued only on presentation of the library card. Books must not be marked or defaced in any manner. The pages should not be folded. Students should examine each book, before borrowing it and report to the

librarian any damage found therein. Should they fail to do so, they will be held responsible for any damage detected after the Use of the book.

Students should replace any library property damaged by them.

Books can be returned to the library on any working day between 9.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m between 12.15 p.m. and 1.30 p.m. and between 3.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m.

At the end of the academic year both the staff and students are expected to return all the books to the library. The librarian will examine the books returned and if any book has been damaged, he / she should replace it with anew copy. Books should be handled with love and care, marking on books is most objectionable. Students are strictly forbidden to tear or scribble on pages of magazines and books. Any student found doing so would be punished severely.

Overdue Charges

Failure to return the books on due dates will entail a fine of Rs.1/- per book per day.

Clearance Certificate

It is only after obtaining a clearance from the library, the hall ticket and transfer certificate will be issued.
