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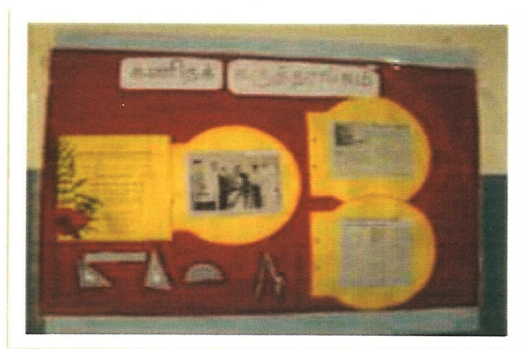
1. PARTICIPATIVE LEARNING

Encourages student involvement, engagement, and collaboration through interactive activities that promote active learning and discussion



2. PROBLEM SOLVING LEARNING

Understanding, analyzing, and resolving issues or challenges through critical thinking, creativity, and collaboration



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3. EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

Learning through hands-on activities, simulations, and real-world experiences to deepen understanding



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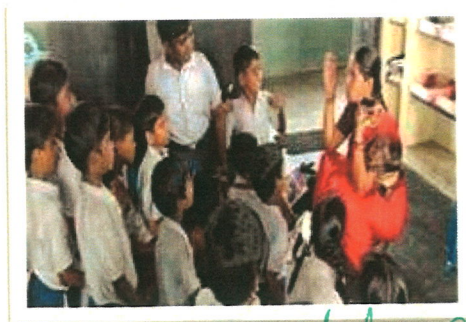
4. FOCUSED GROUP DISCUSSION

A group discussion with a specific topic, guiding questions, and set goals for participants
