

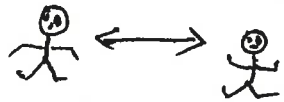


Coronavirus awareness diagram
