



- Understanding of the challenges and opportunities inherent in the teaching profession, as well as the importance of lifelong learning and professional development.


Outcomes and Impact: The internship program yielded several positive outcomes and impacts, including:

- Improved quality of education through the infusion of new ideas, perspectives, and innovative teaching practices brought by M.Ed interns into TEIs.

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

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• Evaluate the effectiveness and impact of the exchange program through feedback from students, instructors, and participating institutions to inform future planning and improvements.


